The Union Township Trustees met in special session at 9:00 am on September 6, 2018, at the Union Township Complex. Roll call showed the following trustees present: Trustee Charles Prince, Trustee John Slater, and Trustee Randy Weekly. Jessica Slater, Fiscal Officer, was absent. Paula Greene was present to take minutes. Mr. Prince led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bills

The Fiscal Officer certified that the money to pay the bills was in the treasury or the process of collection. There were no questions regarding the bills. Mr. Slater moved to approve the bills. Mr. Weekly seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Paula read into the minutes the notice for this meeting that was published in the Newark Advocate on September 5 and had been posted on the township's website.

OPWC Canal and Beaver Run Application - The Township has not received the information requested from the Licking County Engineer's Office. Paula will contact the Engineer's Office.

OPWC Canyon Road Project - Mr. Prince recommended viewing the Canyon Road Project and Ms. McNamara's property pin which was installed by the Engineer's Office. Ms. McNamara has contacted Mr. Prince regarding her request for a new fence and when it would be installed. Mr. Prince said he responded stating he had not visited the site and the Licking County Prosecutor would be revising the settlement agreement. Asst. Prosecutor Austin Lecklider recommends including a detailed description of the fence post.

Trees - Skyline Tree service has removed the oak trees in Jones Addition that were a safety concern and will return to complete the rest of the project later.

Catch Basins - Work has begun on catch basins in the Newark Industrial Park. Mr. Prince approved the purchase of a Sthil concrete saw at the State Bid Price from Buckeye Valley Equipment.

Milliken Railroad Crossing- Paula contacted business owner Lee Zazworsky regarding her railroad contacts. Both have exchanged their contact information and will update any progress. Mr. Slater asked if she included Mr. Sheets, from Bayer Corporations information. Paula said she did not as she has not spoken with Mr. Sheets. Mr.

Zazworsky advised he has been in contact with the Rob O'Neill, owner of the Industrial Park. Mr. Slater has noticed the Wyoming-Genesis vehicles in the area since our meeting at the railroad tracks.

ODOT Salt Contract - Mr. Prince said Walnut Township's cost of salt for the upcoming winter would be \$81.00 per ton and feels our price will be similar. ODOT charged approximately \$46.00 per ton last year.

Mr. Prince recommends mixing grits with the salt. Dave cautioned the use of grits as the residents in the sub-divisions would complain. It was discussed using the new truck in the subdivisions to spread salt and the trucks on the road would use a 50/50 mix.

Mr. Prince said Walnut Township is going to maximize the use of grits. Mr. Slater suggested finding a second salt provider.

Mr. Prince asked Paula to contact ODOT regarding our notification of the contract salt price.

Ford F550 - The truck has been delivered and is currently at Ace in Zanesville having equipment installed. The cover plate was making a noise but was immediately addressed.


Solid Waste District Resolution - The Solid Waste District Resolution was read. Mr. Slater moved to approve the resolution. The plan sets the fees for waste disposal. Mr. Weekly seconded the resolution. Roll call as follows: Mr. Slater - yes; Mr. Prince - yes; Mr. Weekly - yes.

As there is no further business the meeting continued to the site of the Canyon Road culvert and Ms. McNamara's property pin.


After viewing the property pin, Mr. Slater expressed concerns of where Ms. McNamara would want the post installed by the pin (front, back or sides). Dave was directed to provide a drawing of the post and its supports to Mr. Lecklider. The drawing would be included in the settlement agreement. The fence post would not be installed until we have received Ms. McNamara's signed consent.

There being no further business, Mr. Slater moved to adjourn. Mr. Weekly seconded the motion. Motion passed.
