

Proposed Fire District  
Village of Hebron and Union Township  
Meeting Notes  
11 February 2019

Mr. Prince, Mr. Layton and Chief Mason were present and the meeting was called to order. Others present as indicated on attendance sheet (attached).

It was recognized that these meetings are open and published accordingly; therefore no violation of the Sunshine Laws exist if one or more trustee or council member is present at the same time. Likewise, Trustee Prince is to suggest to the others on the Union Township Board that the ground rules recently adopted by the board be amended to reflect same.

**Discussion about the advantages of creating a fire and ambulance district vs a fire district:**

- Biggest advantage to a fire and ambulance district is more than one elected official from each entity could serve on the Board of Fire and Ambulance District Directors. This will be further discussed moving forward.

**Discussion about the area to be included in a fire district (or fire and ambulance district):**

- It was decided by this group that the fire or fire and ambulance district should encompass ALL of Union Township.

**Discussion about the importance of the fire district (or fire and ambulance district) continuing to contract with Granville Twp. Fire Department for services:**

- This group supports the idea of an agreement between the fire district (or fire and ambulance district) board of directors and Granville Twp.

**Discussion on establishing the name for the fire district (or fire and ambulance district):**

- Suggestions should be given in writing to either Mr. Layton or Mr. Prince prior to the meeting on 25 March 2019.

**Discussion about short-term staffing at a location to be determined in the central area of Union Township prior to the formation of fire district (or fire and ambulance district):**

- Short term goal is to have a medic unit ready to respond from established location by 01 July, 2019.
- Long term goal is to have a medic unit and an engine/tanker available to respond from same location as soon as practical thereafter.
- Short term goal of staffing with two additional persons (1 FTE and 1 PTE now, adding at least one more PTE when the engine/tanker is placed in service).

**Discussion about securing an outside firm to help with marketing:**

- No action taken at this time.
