

**Union Township Trustees End of Year Meeting
December 30, 2022**

The Union Township Trustees met in a special session at 9:00 am on December 30, 2022. The fiscal officer's roll call showed the following trustees: John Slater, and Jeff Sharps. Trustee Roger Start, was absent. Paula Greene, Township Administrator was also present. Trustee Slater led the Pledge of Allegiance. Guest: Andrew and Kelly Gulick.

Bills – Mr. Sharps motioned, and Mr. Slater seconded to approve the bills. Motion carried.
