

UNION TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES  
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
December 28, 2020

The Union Township Trustees met in regular session via zoom on December 28, 2020, at 7:00 pm with Trustee Charlie Prince opening with the pledge of allegiance. Fiscal Officer Jessica Slater's roll call showed Trustees Charlie Prince, John Slater, and Randy Weekly. Township Administrator Paula Greene and Road Supervisor Dave Cable were present. Guests via Zoom: Martha Cable, Bill McWilliams, Patty Costello, Leslie Herro, and other unidentified zoom callers.

Minutes

Mr. Slater moved to approve the November 23 (Boyer Map Amendment) minutes, November 23, and December 7 Regular Trustee minutes. Mr. Weekly seconded. Motion carried.

Bills

The clerk certified the money to pay the bills was in the treasury or is in the process of collection. Mr. Slater motioned to pay the bills. Mr. Weekly seconded. Motion carried.

Mrs. Slater said the Township is still receiving Energy Cooperative and Spectrum bills for the satellite station and asked again for those accounts to be transferred to the Refugee Canyon Fire District. Spectrum will only speak with Mr. Weekly as he set up the service for 6265. Ms. Slater asked Mr. Weekly directly to contact Spectrum. Mr. Prince said the issues would be resolved soon.

Road and Bridge

Christmas Eve/Day Snow Storm - Mr. Prince thanked the Street Department for clearing the roads. Dave said the grit mix was not cutting the snow and ice as well as it typically does.

Tractor/Mower – Dave reported on Tractor and Mower prices:

Option 1) Southeastern New Holland & boom mower – mid \$140,000

Option 2) AgPro: John Deere Tractor/Alamo mower \$162,000

Option 3) Advantage Ag: New Holland (2020 demo) w/Samurai mower \$124,703.00

Option 3 is available now. Option 1 needs to be ordered and may arrive in April. Option 3 allows for trade-ins. Dave and Mr. Slater will investigate the Samurai mower. Mrs. Slater will explore financing options.

Fire/EMS

Mr. Prince reported that the Apparatus building would be completed within the next two days. The final plumbing bill came to \$5,789.93 (with heaters). The original estimate was \$5,000, w/o the heaters; they were estimated to cost \$2,000. Additional stone is needed in front of the station and the loop driveway.

CARES Funding


The Complex flooring is currently being installed. The touchless fixtures have been installed.
