

Special Meeting
Union Township Trustees
January 26, 2021

The Union Township Trustees held a Special Meeting on January 26, 2021. Chairman John Slater called the meeting to order at 9:07 am. Roll Call showed Trustees Charlie Prince and Randy Weekly present. Paula Greene, the Township Administrator, was present.

The purpose of this meeting was to review, discuss, and possibly pass a Resolution to replace the Township's 1.8 mill Fire and EMS levy for the May election.

Mr. Slater said the Licking County Prosecutor's Office provided a resolution. Mr. Weekly moved to place the 1.8 mill Fire/EMS replacement levy on the May ballot. Mr. Prince seconded.

The Resolution will be forwarded to the Licking County Auditor's Office. The Resolution to place the levy on the ballot will be presented at the next Township meeting on February 1.



Mr. Prince moved to authorize Paula Greene to sign bank documents regarding the tractor and mower purchase. Mr. Weekly seconded. Motion carried.




