

**Union Township**  
**March 3, 2025**  
**Regular Trustee Meeting**

The Union Township Trustees met on March 3, 2025, at 7:00 pm for a regular meeting. The Fiscal Officer Karen Nethers Roll Call showed the following trustees: Roger Start, Jeff Sharps and John Slater. Administrator Paula Greene and Dave Cable, Road Superintendent, were present. Trustee Start led the Pledge of Allegiance. Guests – Joe Garrett, Treble Representative and Bill McWilliams.

Minutes –Mr. Slater motioned, and Mr. Sharps seconded to approve the February 27 meeting minutes. Motion carried.

Bills – Mr. Sharps motioned, and Mr. Slater, seconded to approve the bills. Motion carried.

**Public Comments** – Joe Garrett of Treble Aggregation requested that the Trustees sign an addendum to the 2014 contract and an Authorization Letter. Mr. Garrett provided a detailed update on the current state of electric aggregation. The Trustees advised Mr. Garrett that the documents he wished to have signed tonight must be reviewed and approved by the Township’s legal counsel. Mr. Garrett expressed concern about potential rising rates if the Trustees waited for approval. Ms. Greene advised Mr. Garrett to send documents requiring Trustees’ approval as soon as he receives them, rather than waiting until the Township meeting.

**Motion:** Mr. Start moved, and Mr. Sharps second, to approve the signing of the Treble Documents upon the approval of the Prosecutor’s Office. The motion carried.

**Fiscal Officer** – The budget, due April 1, 2025, is in process of completion.

**Road and Bridge** – No issues to report. Mr. Start questioned the weight limit program and would like to see a resolution limiting truck weight on roads before the winter of 2025 begins.

Mowing Bid – Bids will be opened during the next township meeting. Two vendors have requested bid packets.


Waste Disposal Renewal – Shackleford's submitted a bid for renewal. The proposed increase for the monthly trash pick-up fee is \$1.50. Recycling and tote rentals will remain unchanged. After discussion, the following motion was made:


- **Motion:** Mr. Slater moved, and Mr. Sharps seconded to accept the price increase of \$1.50 for trash pick-up and to continue the contract. Motion carried.

Public Comments – none



